Treatment of combination Rx.

Testosterone will increase the PSH level.

Explore green light laser.

Laser Rx for BPH.

Assess patients according to IDSS Score and treat accordingly.

Creatinine not necessary in initial evaluation of BPH pt. (unless other kidney issues present.)

IPSS on everyone.

Use of anti-muscarinics in PBH.

Use 5 ARI prior to TURP to decrease blood loss.

Avodart vs. Prostan.

Taking pt. off x blocker possibly.
